Round Table on Law on Protection and Proceedings of Children and Juvenile in Criminal Procedure and Bylaw on application of educational recommendations towards juveniles was held on April 12th, 2010 in Banja Luka.

The Law on protection and proceedings of children and juvenile in criminal procedure is a part of reform of Juvenile Criminal Law and its harmonization with the highest European standards. Special quality of it is that the Law has put upfront alternative measures that would, properly applied, have educational role and they would contribute to the normal development of a child and it would strengthen his/hers personal responsibility.

By putting in effect Bylaw on application of educational recommendations towards juveniles created are conditions for completely new approach to the children who are in conflict with the law.

Taking in account that the Law will be applicable as of January 1st, 2011, it is very important that in year of preparation for implementation of the Law all necessary activities for that are undertaken.
