

After finished elementary school all children younger than 17 years of age can enroll in high school. Enrolment of a student to first grade is based on the general and special accomplishment in elementary school¹.

General accomplishment reflects the success of mean average grade at the end of the year rounded to two decimals, multiplied by two in the sixth and seventh grade and by three in the eighth and ninth grade. Thus, a maximum of 50 points can be achieved.

Evaluating special accomplishment is made from 5 subjects in the eighth and ninth grade so that the mean final grade of subjects for the eighth and ninth grade is multiplied by two and rounds to two decimals. These 5 subjects are different for different professions and are regulated by the Regulation on registration of students in first grade of high schools ("Official Gazette of Republic of Srpska", number 37/09). On this basis a maximum of 20 points can be achieved.

By both these criteria a maximum of 70 points can be achieved.

The candidate who in the June deadline has less than 60 points cannot be enrolled in General Education High School and Vocational Technical School in the first (June) enrollment period.

All high schools during the school year organize an information day called "School's open door day" for students of the ninth grade of elementary schools². The goal of "School's open door day" is that candidates get familiar with:

- a. Type of school,
- b. Professions or occupations educated at school,
- v. Occupation for which the student will be able to do after finishing the school,
- g. Curriculum and
- d. Opportunities for further education of students
