

1. What can a student and / or parent do who believes that in the enrollment to high school the rights of the child have been violated?

Enrollment of regular students to secondary schools is carried out in June and July terms based on public contest announced by the founder. (The Law on Secondary Education, "Official Gazette of RS" No. 74/08, Article 45.)

This year it is:

1. in June term, from June 13 to 23. 2011.

2. in July term, from July 01 to 12. 2011.

The Ministry of Education and Culture has announced the Contest for enrollment of students in first grade of secondary schools in Republic of Srpska in school year 2011/2012. on the portal www.eobrazovanje.com and on the portal of the Government of Republic of Srpska (www.vladars.net) – on the page of the Ministry of Education and Culture.

If the student and / or parent believes that contest is not implemented in a determined manner and in accordance with the law, which violates the rights of the child, it has the right to file a complaint to principal of the school.

The Law on Secondary Education in Article 46. provides:

1. Participant of a contest for enrollment in first grade or his parent, guardian or adoptive parent (hereinafter referred to as a parent) who believes that contest for enrollment is not conducted in a determined manner and in accordance with the law, and that this violated his rights, has the right to file a complaint to the principal within eight days from the date of publication of the list of accepted students.

2. Principal of school shall make a decision on the complaint within 24 hours.

3. A student who is dissatisfied with the decision of principal of school may appeal to the school board within 3 days of the date of a receipt of the decision referred to in Paragraph 2. of this Article.

4. School board makes a decision on the appeal referred to in Paragraph 3. of this Article within 3 days from the date of receipt of the appeal.

5. School board decision is final.
